

STUDENT WAIVER SHORT TERM AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

I, _____ (Student's name), will be participating in the 2017 Puerto Rico J-Term Program, henceforth known as "Program", offered through Mitchell Hamline School of Law ("Law School"). Although the Law School is sponsoring this opportunity, I understand that the Law School will not be supervising me.

In exchange for being allowed to participate in this voluntary Program, I agree that:

1. I will be responsible for my own personal safety and my own personal property.
2. I understand that there are a number of risks inherent with traveling to and studying in Puerto Rico. I acknowledge that I have been provided website information for US Consular Information as well as the Centers for Disease Control information. I understand that it is my responsibility to stay updated on any changes to this information.
3. I release and will not attempt to hold the Law School or any trustees, officers, directors, employees, agents or representatives of the Law School liable for any injuries, losses or damages to either my person or property that may arise during or result from my participation in the Program, my activities or any travel incident thereto. For illustration only, such examples include any loss of property, injury, illness, or death due to crimes, political unrest, use of modes of transportation, and activities on the part of fellow participants, agencies, and organizations, persons or groups with which Mitchell Hamline contracts for the provision of services for the program. This release does not apply to intentional, willful, or wanton misconduct of Mitchell Hamline, or any trustees, officers, directors, or agents of the Law School.
4. I and my heirs and successors and assigns agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Law School, its past and present trustees, officers, directors, employees, agents, and the heirs, successors, and assigns of and from each, from any and all loss, cost, damage, liability or expense (including reasonable attorneys' fees), resulting in or arising from my participation in the Program.
5. If I decide to leave the Program before its completion, I will provide the Law School with advance written notice of my intention to leave the Program. If I leave the Program prior to its completion, the Law School has no liability to provide or arrange for transportation, housing, dining or other services to me in connection with my early departure.
6. I will comply with all rules and regulations issued by the Law School and the foreign institution. It is within the Law School and the foreign institution's discretion to determine that my violation of such rules and regulations warrants my termination from the Program. In that event, I may be sent home at my own expense.
