CORE COURSES

- Arbitration Law online (2 credits)
- Mediation online (3 credits)
- Negotiation online (3 credits)
- Theories of Conflict in-person (2 credits)

PRACTICE COURSES

- Clinic: Employment Discrimination Mediation Representation (3 credits) in-person
- Clinic: Mediation (2 or 3 credits) this clinic is open to in-person and blended students
- Competition: Mediation Representation (by instructor approval after try-out)
- Externship: Alternative Dispute Resolution (3 credits)
- Externship with ADR Component by DRI Director approval (1 4 credits)
