She wants to sign some European disco star or something (Abba meets Meatloaf?). Not sure why, but she is keen on him. I think she is a little off. We shouldn't let her pay this guy much. Plus there may be union issues if he is in the Screen Actors Guild – you probably also ought to get some sort of assurance on this.

Anyways she will tell you what she needs.

One thing – you have to do this deal today – at least the basic points. Don't put it in writing just yet – wait for further instructions, but at least get to an agreement with the Euro-star's attorney on the key promises from both sides.

Go ahead and bring the client to the negotiations – just to get this done quickly, but make sure you do most of the talking.
