## EXT-1015 : Externship: Court of Appeals

Eligible students cannot be working or volunteering for any county attorney's office, public defender's office, or any private law firm.

Students intern with judges of the Minnesota Court of Appeals and participate in a variety of court and clerking activities and attend appellate arguments. Students are assigned to individual judges by the Chief Judge. Students must have regular daytime hours available in order to fulfill the time requirements.

The Court of Appeals accepts one student. This course may be taken for 3 or 4 credits. Registration by instructor consent only. To apply, students must send transcript, resume, and writing sample to [externships@mitchellhamline.edu](mailto:externships@mitchellhamline.edu), by listed submission deadline. To apply, students must have a 3.5 or better GPA or be in the top 15% of their class.
