

How to Report a Problem on Apple Pay: Official Support Steps

How do I report a problem on Apple Pay?

To report an Apple Pay issue like unauthorized charges or failed transactions, 1-(888)(400)(8831) visit reportaproblem.apple.com and sign in with your Apple ID at 1-(888)(400)(8831) for guided navigation.
