## **COMPLAINT**

## **OFFENSE**

- (2) obtains for the actor custody of property by intentionally deceiving the third person with a false representation which is known to be false, made with intent to defraud and which does defraud the person to whom it is mads; or
- (3) by swindling, whether by artifice, trick, device or any other means, obtains property of another person

609.05 Liability for crimes of another: A person is criminally liable for a crime committed by another if the person intentionally aids, advises, hires, counsels or conspires with or otherwise procures the other to commit the crime

## Count 2

609.17 Attempted Theft. Whoever with intent to commit a crime, doesn't act which is a substantial step toward in more than preparation but the Commission of a crime.

609.05 Liability for crimes of another. A person is criminally liable for a crime committed by another if the person intentionally aids, advises, hires, counsels or conspires with or otherwise procures the other to commit the crime
