Petition to Exceed Semester Credit Limit

School policy prohibits students from registering for more than 15 credits in either fall or spring semesters. See <u>Catalog 1.07 F.a.</u> On a showing of extraordinary circumstances and only with advance permission from the Vice Dean for Academic and Faculty Affairs, a student may register for up to 17 credits in a fall or spring semester. The Vice Dean for Academic and Faculty Affairs will rarely, if ever, determine that additional credit is justified.

The financial cost associated with spending an additional semester or semesters in school does NOT constitute an extraordinary circumstance. The desire to graduate "early" – i.e., in less than the number of semesters that the program in which the student is enrolled ordinarily requires – does NOT constitute an extraordinary circumstance.
